- 1 Find a recipe online
- 2 Nominate a cameraperson – or multiple camera-people! – to take photos of each step in the recipe
- 3 Prepare the food and take photos!
- 4 While the food is cooking, talk about what the steps are and the best ways to say them for the audio recording
- 5 Record the instructions for each step on a different slide in Spark Video
- 6 Decide what photo to use with each step in the instructions and load them into Spark Video
- 7 Don't forget a title page and a final page!
- 8 Preview and play around with different themes, music and volumes
- 9 Export as a video and share
- 10 Get appropriate image releases if you want to share the video publicly



The next time you plan a group cooking activity or class, use Adobe Spark Video to make a photo-movie with audio instructions of the recipe you're cooking

- iPad
- Adobe Spark Video App

## tips & ideas

- Make sure you are signed into the App with an Adobe ID before starting. You need internet connectivity to do this, however once signed in you can use the app offline
- Have a play with the App beforehand to get to know it
- You can use this App on a computer through the web browser if you have internet connection
