- Preload the iPads with fun. copyright-free backgrounds
- Print examples so that people can get some ideas
- Set up an area with the green screen make sure it has even light
- Get participants to choose a background
- Take the photo in front of the green screen
- Show how to edit the photos so that people can swap their background and have a play
- Export the final image to the computer using Airdrop
 - Name and organise the files so you can find them later
 - Open the photos in an application like Preview, then print and laminate
