- 1 Preload the iPads with fun, copyright-free backgrounds
- 2 Print examples so that people can get some ideas
- 3 Set up an area with the green screen – make sure it has even light
- 4 Get participants to choose a background
- 5 Take the photo in front of the green screen
- 6 Show how to edit the photos so that people can swap their background and have a play
- 7 Export the final image to the computer using Airdrop
- 8 Name and organise the files so you can find them later
- 9 Open the photos in an application like Preview, then print and laminate



Engage the whole community by holding a Family Photo Booth day where everyone gets a chance to have a photo with their family that they can edit, print, laminate and take home

tips & ideas

- Put photos onto USBs to keep for later
- Use a portable green screen to take photos wherever people are comfortable
- Use more than one iPad so participants can edit photos while more are taken
- Nominate a photographer to take the photos
- Advertise the event by holding a workshop to make posters beforehand
