- Decide what the different shots will look like by making a storyboard. Pick about six and don't worry about sound
- 3 Export the files onto the computer and upload them to AppBook
- Film each different shot using your device. Try to keep each shot to only 20 seconds
- Arrange the files in the order you like
 - 6 Trim each clip to be the right length
 - 7 Turn off the audio on the footage and choose music instead
 - 8 Make a title
 - 9 Save and export!

- Have a play with the App before working on it with participants to get to know how it works
- Check out some examples before starting to get inspired. Watch them as a group and talk about which bits people liked and why those bits were good
- Think about trying to have a mixture of different kinds of shots. There might be: close-up of faces; long shots; kids doing activates like drawing; far away action like running; up close action like playing with other kids; a portrait of parents with little ones; outside shots and inside shots
- This can easily be offline if you have already a movie-editing App on your device
